

## Calendar

The CSU Conservatory spring semester begins January 19, 2010 and runs for fourteen weeks through the last week of April 2010.

## Tuition and Fees

Tuition for a weekly **45 minute** individual lesson is \$18.00 per lesson. Lessons are purchased by the fourteen semester and may be paid for in one payment of \$272 or in three payments of \$104, \$84 & \$84.

Tuition for a weekly **30 minute** individual lesson is \$12.75 per lesson. Lessons are purchased by the fourteen week semester. Tuition may be paid in one payment of \$198.50 or in three installments of \$79.50, \$59.50 & \$59.50.

A \$20 yearly registration fee applies to all new enrollment in our private lesson programs. The pricing listed above includes this fee.

**Enrollment** Registration for our fall semester of private lessons is open now. Please phone 706.641-5124 to register. Space is limited. Early registration is advised.

Provided space is available, new enrollment is accepted throughout each semester. In such cases tuition will be pro-rated.

**Schedule** Both late afternoon and evening lesson times are available. Specific lesson times will be arranged individually between parent and instructor following registration.

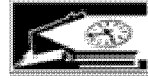

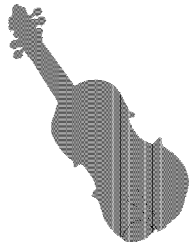
## Private Lessons on all Band & Orchestral Instruments

### Instruments

Lessons are offered on Violin, Viola, Cello, String Bass, Flute, Oboe, Clarinet, Saxophone, Bassoon, Trumpet, Horn, Trombone, Tuba & Percussion

### String Instrument Lessons

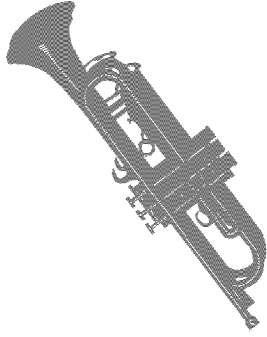
Whether the violin, viola, cello or string bass is chosen, our lessons prepare students to achieve technical proficiency and a passion for their instrument. Our string curriculum emphasizes balanced posture, beautiful tone production, accurate intonation, and general musicianship skills. These lessons are open to students at all levels of advancement. We generally recommend string lessons for students ages six and older.



### Woodwind, Brass and Percussion Lessons

Private lessons are available on all woodwind, brass and percus-

sion instruments. Regardless of the instrument chosen, students learn to express themselves musically, develop personal responsibility and successfully participate in school or church ensembles. We generally recommend lessons on these instruments for students ages 10 and older.



### Instructors

The Music Conservatory's young professional teachers are upper-division and graduate level music majors at the Schwob School of Music, Columbus State University. These instructors are trained and individually selected by the professional applied teaching staff of the Schwob School for positions in the Conservatory. Schwob School of Music faculty continue to mentor and direct Conservatory teachers throughout their association with the Conservatory. The Schwob School of Music was selected as this year's recipient of the University System of Georgia Regents Teaching Excellence Award for Departments and Programs. It is an accredited institutional member of the National Association of Schools of Music and one of the top music schools in the southeast.
